| <p>As part of the work of the Commission's Connections Stakeholder Workshops, metered building water is being introduced for 2011-12. Metered building water will be charged at the same fixed and volumetric rates as a permanent water connection. As part of this market change the Commission requires the introduction of functionality in the Central Systems that identifies Supply Points (SPIDs) that have metered building water.</p> <p>Scottish Water will be responsible for the creation of a SPID and notifying the CMA in respect of existing SPIDs that have metered building water. Current Central Systems functionality will be utilised to allow Scottish Water to fulfill their obligation and to allow Licensed Providers access to this market information. Metered building water Supply Points may be Permanently Disconnected once a building development is completed. Alternatively the SPID may continue as a Water Services Supply Point. Unmetered Building Water will not be affected by these changes.</p> <p>Functionality will need to be added to the Central Systems to identify SPIDs which are metered building water connections. This will be implemented by creating a metered building water flag data item. Scottish Water will be the data item owner. Scottish Water will have responsibility for providing and maintaining the data item and should be able to undertake this via transactions in the Central Systems. This information should be available to both the LP that owns the SPID and LPs that are not the SPID owner. The timescales for providing this information will adhere to the current timescales associated with SPID and meter creation and SPID and meter updates in the CSDs. The CSDs will also have to reflect that a SPID will not be able to change status from metered building water to unmetered building water.</p> |   |  |                  |              |
