Scottish Water is proposing a revision to meter sizing methodology to align with developments in industry practice and meter technical characteristics.

This Change Proposal proposes a number of changes to the Meter Size Data Assessment Sheet, which is found in the Appendices of Forms A, C, F, J and N. The proposed changes will align the methodology for selecting meter size with the Measuring Instruments Directive of the European Union. The proposed changes will give more clear separation of the details of directly and indirectly supplied appliances, as inputs to the meter sizing calculations.

The Operational Code processes affected by this change proposal are:

- Process 1: Application for an individual premises water connection
- Process 3: Application for a water mains/trunk main/service reservoir water connection
- Process 5B: Application for a metered temporary water connection (metered building water)
- Process 8: Installation of a meter for a new Supply Point
- Process 11: Change of meter at the request of the Licensed Provider
- Process 26: Fire Fighting Allowance.
