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A.2.a. ISSUE OR DEFECT WHICH THIS MCCP / OCCP SEEKS TO ADDRESS Required under Market Code Parts 8.7.1 (ii) (b) and 8.8.1 (ii) (b)

Process 28 of the Operational Code sets out the procedures to be followed to verify the details of a meter. This request is made by submitting a verification of meter details form (Form K). This change proposal seeks to address a number of issues with the current process 28 and form K.

Amendments are required to Form K to align it with current process and practice. There are a number of fields which, following the addition of the Deregistration Process, are obsolete and not relevant to process 28.

In addition, there is a gap in the Operational Code in relation to meter verification processes. There is no separate process for verification of supply arrangements which has led to process 28 being used for this activity. An update of the wording of this process is required to close this gap and ensure clarity on the nature of the request when a Form K is submitted.

A.2.b. DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF THE MCCP / OCCP AND HOW IT MEETS THE MARKET CODE / OPERATIONAL CODE OBJECTIVES AND PRINCIPLES FOR THE MARKET DOCUMENTS Required under Market Code Parts 8.7.1 (ii) (c) and 8.8.1 (ii) (c)

General Description

The purpose of this OCCP is to make amendments to Form K, removing fields which are no longer relevant and can cause confusion with requests. The fields to be removed relate to verification of services such as Roads and Property Drainage, Services to Caravans, Sewerage Connections etc. The removal of any such service element from a Supply Point is dealt with under Processes 31 and 32 for Deregistration of Supply Points.

The amendments to Form K will also enable Licensed Providers to select the type of meter verification required; a verification of the meter technical details (e.g. the number of dial digits) or verification of the supply arrangements (e.g. which meter serves a property). This will improve the information captured, resulting in a better customer experience.

Amendments to the wording of Process 28 to include verification of supply arrangements will also be made. This will close the process gap that exists, provide clarity to all parties on the nature of the request and further improve the customer experience.
